



Unit Signage Installation Instructions

All properties with multiple residences sharing a single driveway require additional signage. As stated in the Rural Address Bylaw 2009-016, signs must be installed in a conspicuous place near the correct residences on your property. They must be easily visible to anyone entering your property, especially emergency services.

Unit signs are 20 cm x 20 cm (8" x 8") hi-reflective blue signs with white letters, the same as your rural address sign installed at the main access of your property.



Residences are labelled with letters, progressing down the alphabet as you move further away from the road allowance. For example, the house closest to the road allowance is House "A", the next closest is House "B", and so on.

It is mandatory to use the blue signs provided, however you may mount your sign either to the metal post provided or on to any other permanent structure. We advise contacting Alberta One-Call before you do any installation at 1-800-242-3447. Please note all signs must be properly installed by June 1, 2010 to avoid penalty.
