VULCAN COUNTY POLICY NO. 12-2213

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GIS/GPS SERVICES POLICY

PURPOSE

This policy is to generally allow the services performed by the County GIS/GPS technician to be contracted to the public on a cost recovery basis.

POLICY GUIDELINES

- 1. The County, through the Administration Office is able to provide certain technical services such as digital mapping, supply aerial photos, conducting GPS services, printing, etc. to the public.
- 2. All services provided to the public must adhere to licensing and agreements held with in Vulcan County.
- 3. County GIS/GPS work will take priority over any public requests and the scheduling of any public requests will be at the discretion of the GIS/GPS Technician and County Administrator. Although GIS and GPS services are conducted within Vulcan County it is not the intentions of Vulcan County to compete with private industry services.
- 4. These services are supplied to the public on a cost recovery basis. The fees for these services are referenced in the Fees for Services Bylaw 2011-011.
- 5. Community groups may be eligible for an exception to the Fee Bylaw to accommodate small one time projects at the discretion of the Chief Administrative Officer.

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
