BYLAW 2026-016

Being a Special Tax Bylaw to authorize and establish the tax rates to be levied against designated industrial properties in Vulcan County for the 2026 taxation year.

WHEREAS the Province of Alberta has centralized the assessment of Designated Industrial Property (DIP), and;

WHEREAS the Province of Alberta has required municipalities to levy an extra tax on the owning rate payers of said DIP, and;

WHEREAS the Province of Alberta has set the required mill rate for this levy via Ministerial Order MAG:003/26;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Vulcan County duly assembled in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. That the Chief Administrative Officer for Vulcan County is hereby authorized and directed to levy the following rate of taxation, as established in this Bylaw, on all Designated Industrial Property in Vulcan County for the 2026 taxation year:
