



Full Time Seasonal Equipment Operator 1

Road Construction Crew

Vulcan County is currently accepting applications for the position of Equipment Operator 1 for the 2025 and beyond road construction seasons. This is a full-time seasonal position with the designation of Equipment Operator Level 1. Our road Construction crew is team-oriented, but the applicant will occasionally have to work alone unsupervised. The right applicant will receive all applicable training for this position at the discretion of their supervisor. This position reports directly to the Road Construction Foreman.

The position start date is March 17th, 2025, and will end November 14th, 2025, depending on budget and weather. The work week is Monday through Friday, 12 hour days.

Duties will include but are not limited to the operation of multiple pieces of heavy equipment, picking rock, rip rapping culverts and staking slopes for road construction. The equipment being operated will include but not limited to: 627G motor scraper.

Requirements:

- A minimum of a class 5 drivers license with no more than 7 demerits
- A class 1 license with a Q endorsement would be an asset but not necessary
- Must be able to lift a minimum of 50 pounds
- Must be able to work unsupervised and alone
- Must be mechanically inclined
- Must provide a 5 year commercial drivers abstract with no more than 7 demerits
- Previous equipment experience is an asset but not necessary
