BYLAW 2025-015

Being a Special Tax Bylaw to authorize and establish the tax rates to be levied against assessable property within the Champion District fire protection and recreation areas in Vulcan County for the 2025 taxation year.

WHEREAS the estimated Special Tax levies to be raised by Vulcan County for the purposes of a fire protection area tax is \$63,282 for the Champion District Fire Protection Area.

WHEREAS the estimated Special Tax levies to be raised by Vulcan County for the purposes of a recreational services tax is \$53,347 for the Champion District Fire Recreation Area.

NOW THEREFORE under the authority of Section 382 of the *Municipal Government Act*, Chapter M26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000, and amendments thereto, the Council of Vulcan County duly assembled in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. That the Chief Administrative Officer for Vulcan County is hereby authorized and directed to levy the following rates of taxation, as established in this Bylaw, on the assessed value of the property in the Champion District fire protection and recreation areas as shown on the assessment roll of Vulcan County.

- a. The Fire Protection Areas subject to the special tax are outlined in Schedule "A" attached.
- b. The Recreation Areas subject to the special tax are outlined in Schedule "B" attached.

2. For the 2025 year there shall be levied against all assessable properties within Champion District Fire Protection Area the following tax rate to generate the required sums, in accordance with the approved budget:

3. For the 2025 year there shall be levied against all assessable properties within Champion District Recreation Area the following tax rate to generate the required sums, in accordance with the approved and submitted budgets:

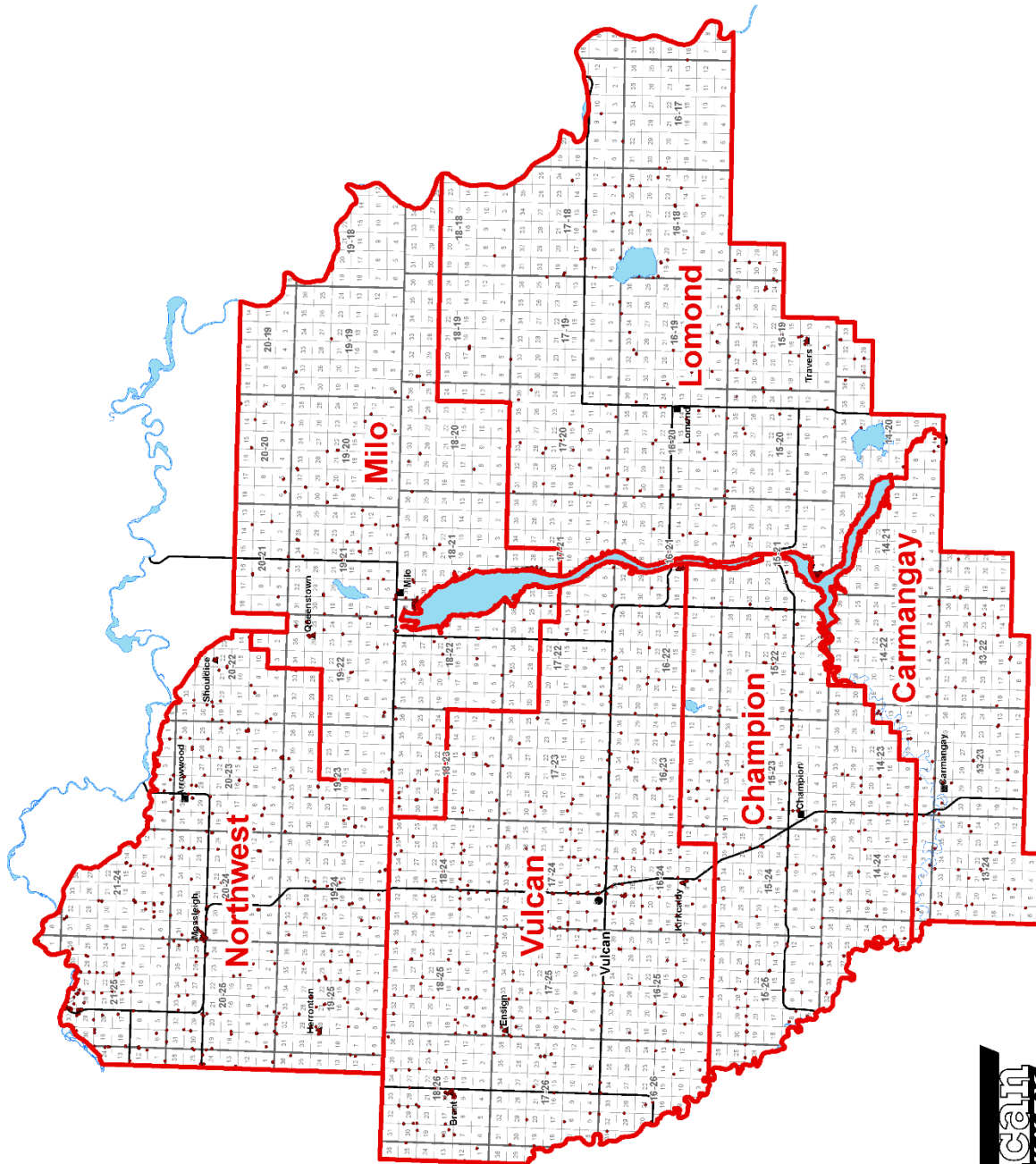

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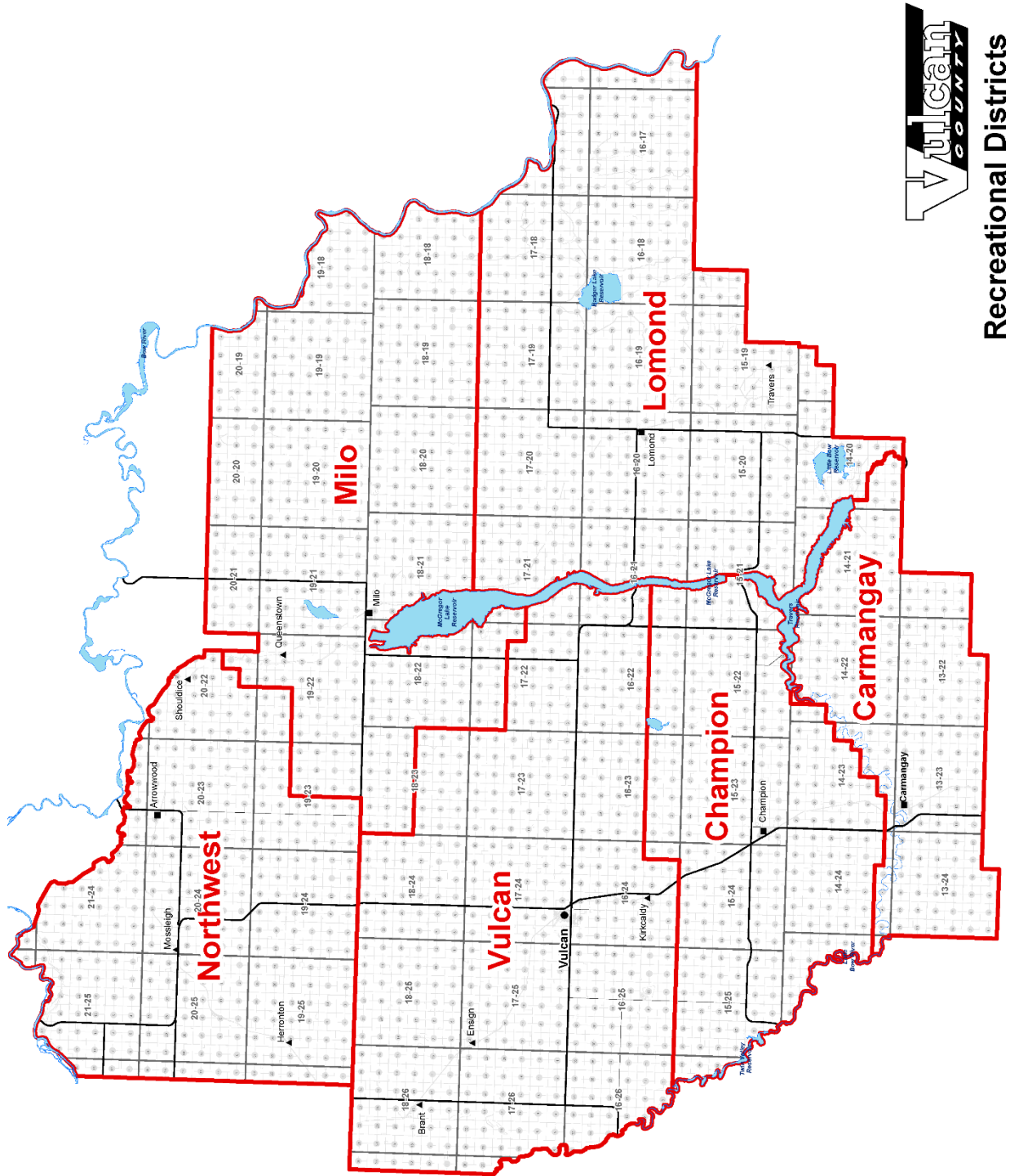
