



Council Highlights

November 5, 2025 Vulcan County Council Meeting

Public Input Session is held at every Council Meeting, usually at 11:00 a.m. (always confirm the time before attending). This gives members of the public the opportunity to bring forward concerns to Council, or ask questions of Council.

Financial Matters

3rd Quarter Reporting

Council reviewed the financial information for the nine months ending September 30, 2025. The actual figures have been compared to the approved final budget for the year and have also been compared to the forecasted figures for the 3rd quarter.

Vulcan Arena and Pool Funding Allocations

Council approved that \$81,000 be provided for the Town of Vulcan Arena and \$91,000 for the Lions Community Pool for the 2026-2027 Recreational Facility Funding Cycle.

2026 Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA)

Council approved the 2026 Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) Allocation at a rate of 2.158%.

2025 Food Bank Funding

Council approved funding of \$2,000 for the Vulcan Food Bank.

2026 FCSS Funding

Council received a funding request from FCSS for 2026, which will be added to the 2026 Interim Budget for review.

Mossleigh Water Line

Council awarded a contract for the installation of a new water line in Mossleigh to United Utilities at a cost of \$109,263.47.

Agricultural Service Board Bursary

Council approved a change to the Agricultural Service Board Bursary Policy, allowing for 6 bursaries of \$1,000 (up from 2 bursaries).

Other Matters

- Council discussed County ratepayers use of the Transfer sites.
- Council will be heading to the RMA Convention on November 17th and will have meetings with the Minister of Agriculture and Irrigation, Minister of Forestry and Parks, and the Minister of Assisted Living and Social Services.
- County Department Reporting and Councillor Reports were reviewed.
