March 11, 2026 Vulcan County Council Meeting

Bylaws

Land Use Bylaw Amendment - Bylaw 2026-007 - Rezone (Section 14-15-21 W4 & E 15-15-21 W4) from Rural General to Rural Industrial

Council gave first reading to Bylaw 2026-007, which authorizes Administration to schedule a Public Hearing and notify affected stakeholders. The purpose of the rezone application is to change the land use from Rural General to Rural Industrial to enable the development of a Data Processing Operation and supporting infrastructure.

Borrowing Bylaw - Bylaw 2025-033 - Marquis Foundation Building

Council gave third and final reading to Bylaw 2025-033, which authorizes Vulcan County to incur indebtedness by the issuance of debenture(s) in the amount of \$1,249,095 for the purpose of funding Vulcan County's contribution towards the Marquis Foundation Building project.

Parking Bylaw 2025-030

Council gave second and third reading, thus approving Parking Bylaw 2025-030 as presented by Administration.

Financial Matters

Yearend Transfers to Reserve

Prior to closing out the 2025 yearend, unspent 2025 funds should be set aside for use in future years. Unexpended operating funds are to be placed in reserves relating to the specific department that the funds were previously raised.

Council approved the transfer of \$1,011,000 to operating reserves and \$1,500,000 to capital reserves, based on the net surplus (unspent funds) from the 2025 yearend.

- Council reviewed the Administrative Write-Off Policy Reporting in closed session.
