ALL THAT PORTION OF THE ORIGINAL EAST-WEST ROAD ALLOWANCE WHICH LIES BETWEEN
NW SEC 12-14-25-4 AND SW SEC 13-14-25-4,
CONTAINING 0.69 HECTARES (1.70 ACRES) MORE OR LESS

The proposed road closure is illustrated on the map attached and can be viewed at the Vulcan County office. Take notice that a public hearing to consider Bylaw 2026-022 will be held on August 12th, 2026, at 10:30 a.m. in Vulcan County Council Chambers. Any person who claims to be affected prejudicially by the proposed bylaw must register their concerns, in writing, to the Chief Administrative Officer no later than 4:00 p.m. on August 7th, 2026.

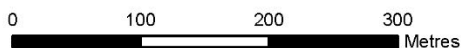
